The committee is very pleased to award the Dhira B. Mahoney Prize for the best Arthurian book (published in 2021 or 2022) to Joseph Sullivan, for his edition and translation of Ulrich Fuetrer's *Iban* (Boydell, 2022). The committee commended Sullivan for his thorough, erudite, and yet accessible introduction to Fuetrer's late medieval Arthurian romance, as well as for his exemplary editing of the manuscripts and his fine translation. As one committee member noted, "this edition is solid and will be the standard for the foreseeable future." The committee praised the edition and translation for making an important late medieval text available to both scholars and students who do not read medieval German.
